- 1. Introductions: Appreciation to Linda Cohen for offering her home & backyard deck as a meeting location.
- 2. Approval of February 25, 2021 SCW board meeting minutes. Linda Cohen offered an addendum to the minutes that which better describes her accomplishments and qualifications to the board. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Linda Cohn and seconded by Sue Baklarz.
- 3. Bank Account Update: Joe Reynolds stated that we have \$4,452.07 in the BCB Bank Account & \$6,176.24 in the PayPal account. This gives SCW a total of \$10,628.31. We made \$500.00 from Fromosa Corporate Cleanup in Union Beach, \$236.99 from the SCW Bonfire Mother Day's HSC T-Shirt Sale, & \$252.00 from Hazlet Township for a SCW spring cleanup at NATCO Park.
- 4. SCW spent \$946.00 on May 18,2021 towards Board insurance to ACH Debit / John C. Conklin.
