Tidal Stage = Incoming tide (High tide at 9:47pm).

Seaweed = Sea lettuce (Ulva), Rhodophyta gracilaria (red algae or red-branching filaments), Agardh's Red Weed (Agardhiella sp.) found in abundance around the edge of the beach. Beach Tangleballs (clumps of intertwine plant parts).

300+ Atlantic Silversides or spearing (Menidia menidia) 2 inches to 2.5 inches long. 1 adult silverside about 4.5 inches long

100+ Salps or sea grapes (Salpidae)

5+ Striped Killifish (Fundulus majalis)

4 Juvenile or peanut bunker/Menhaden (Brevoortia tyrannus), each between 2.2 to 3 inches long.

5 Blue-claw crabs (Callinectes sapidus)

5 juvenile Striped Burrfish (Chilomycterus schoepfi)

1 juvenile Northern stargazer (Astroscopus guttatus)

1 Skeleton Shrimp (Caprellidae)

*Many horseshoe crab molts found on the beach
