10+ Grass or shore shrimp (Palaemonetes sp.)

5+ Eastern mud snails (Tritia obsoleta)

1 juvenile Summer founder or fluke (Paralichthys dentatus)

1 juvenile silver or sand perch (Bairdiella chrysoura)

1 juvenile cunner (Tautogolabrus adspersus)

1 juvenile blackfish or tautog (Tautoga onitis)

1 long-wristed hermit crab (Pagurus longicarpus)

A few empty and washed up horseshoe crab molts aound along the edge of the beach.
