Interesting Sea life or items found on or near the beach:

- Many horseshoe crab molts scattered on the beach.
- Numerous amounts of trash scattered along the edge of the beach.
- Clusters of Sea Squirts (subphylum Urochordata, also called Tunicata)
- 1 Brown Pelican (Pelecanus occidentalis)

Life found in Seine Net 500+ Atlantic Silverside or spearing (Menidia menidia). 20+/- Bay Anchovies (Anchoa mitchilli) 20+/- Striped Killifish (Fundulus majalis) 10 hermit crabs (Pagurus spp.) 3 Snapper Bluefish (Pomatomus saltatrix) 2 Juvenile Blue-claw crabs (Callinectes sapidus) 2 juvenile Silver Perch (Bairdiella chrysoura) 1 juvenile Atlantic Rock Crab (Cancer irroratus) 1 Adult Common Grass Shrimp (Palaemonetes pugio)
